COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS March 7, 2024

Actions/discussion that took place:

- Approved the monthly financial reports of the treasurer and the financial secretary. February bills paid were \$36,850.86; income was \$10,378; pass-through was \$7,473.17; and deficit was \$18,999.69. \$10,000 was transferred from the Moyer account to pay bills. The balance in the Escrow account is \$12,268.18. The balance in the Memorial account is \$24,860.78. The natural gas budget is \$1,382.56 over budget, and the weekly envelope category is behind. The repair/maintenance category is over budget by \$5,196.25. The 2023 audit will occur March 16.
- Committee reports were received from Christian Education, Worship and Music, Jack and Jill, Social Ministry, Property, and Finance.
- Property reported the roof leak that has been causing the drip in the hallway between the Sanctuary and Luther Hall has been located and appears to have been sealed. Christian Education noted that snow tubing was successful, and plans are in place for the Palm Sunday Parade and Easter Egg Hunt. Jack and Jill noted that the recent Tommy's hoagie fundraiser was successful and future fundraisers include PJ Whelihan's dine and donate and Cindy's Deli. Worship and Music reported that the services are now being live streamed on our Facebook page. Youth Group reported the upcoming Movie Night March 16 is free, with snacks to purchase; a pancake brunch April 14 from 11am to 1pm (open to the public); another Movie Night May 18; and a Fellowship Cookout June 2.
- Approved the transfer of membership for Nicole Nothstein and her daughter Aleah to St. John's Lutheran Church in Slatington.
- Received a thank you note from Kelly Keiser for refreshing the memorial fund at Lehighton Animal Hospital to keep the memory of Shawn alive.



BLESSED ARE YOU

The Beatitudes receive little attention, lamented novelist Kurt Vonnegut. "But, often with tears in their eyes, [Christians] demand that the Ten Commandments be posted in public buildings. And, of course, that's Moses, not Jesus. I haven't heard [anyone] demand that the Sermon on the Mount, the Beatitudes, be posted anywhere."

Jesus' Beatitudes have much to teach about selflessness, mourning, peacemaking and more. Jim Berger, author of *Being Sermon on the Mount Christians*, explains that those teachings were once "viewed as a mandate for the faithful." Post-Reformation, they became less law-like and more of a "liberating directive." Berger writes, "For Jesus, being and doing are inseparable. The Sermon is at once theory and praxis. It is not enough to read it or hear it. Jesus intends it to be how we live."

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE FOR 2024 for Nursing and Higher Education

WILLIAM C. & LORETTA K. SHIRAR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP for NURSING was established for the purpose of awarding scholarships to high school seniors or older individual who are pursuing a career as a registered nurse.

- a. Applicant is to be a voting member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, Lehighton.
- b. First consideration is to be given to any person who is pursuing a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing, followed by either a person in Associate Degree program or a Diploma program for registered nursing.
- c. Should there be no candidate from Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, Lehighton, who makes application for these scholarships for nursing, any applicant from the Lehighton Area School District will be considered.
- d. If two or more candidates pursuing a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing or if two or more candidates pursuing an Associate Degree or Diploma program for registered nursing apply for the Scholarship, the determining factor will be the financial need of the student

JEAN D. & ROBERT A. BENNER NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

This memorial nursing scholarship was established for the purpose of awarding a scholarship to a high school senior or older individual who is pursuing a career as a registered nurse. The criteria that will be used in awarding this scholarship is as follows:

- a. First consideration is to be given to persons who are pursuing a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing, followed by either persons in an Associate Degree program or a Diploma program for registered nursing.
- b. Any applicants from the school districts in Carbon County will be considered. This includes the Weatherly, Panther Valley, Jim Thorpe Lehighton, and Palmerton school districts and the Carbon Career & Technical Institute.
- c. If two or more candidates pursuing a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing, or if two or more candidates pursuing an

Associate Degree or Diploma program for registered nursing make application for the scholarships the determining factor will be the financial need of the candidates.

THOMAS L. REISENWEAVER MEMORIAL HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP will be given to a student pursuing a degree in music or a finance-related field.

- a. First consideration will be someone pursuing a degree in music or a finance-related field.
- b. If no applicants in these fields, then preference will be given to a member of Trinity in any course of study.

MARIAN A. ASHNER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN EDUCATION - Up to two scholarships will be given to Lehighton area students majoring in education.

- a. Applicant must be enrolled at a Pennsylvania college or university;
- b. Scholarship recipients can reapply in subsequent years for consideration for additional scholarship grants.

ECKHART FAMILY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship fund was established by Leonard and Gloria Eckhart in memory of Lori Flyte and Dino Eckhart.

- Two scholarships will be given each year to two Lehighton area students majoring in a medical field, a business field, or a trade school program.
- b. Applicants must be pursuing a degree or diploma from an accredited school of higher learning.
- Applicants are to be voting members of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church. If none, applicants will be considered from the Lehighton Area School District.

The MARK KRIEGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP was established to provide help to persons pursuing a degree or diploma from an accredited school of higher learning. Applicant is to be a voting member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church. If none, applicant will be considered from the Lehighton Area School District.

The **TRINITY HIGHER EDUCATION GRANT** was established to provide help to persons pursuing a degree or diploma from an accredited school of higher learning. 
